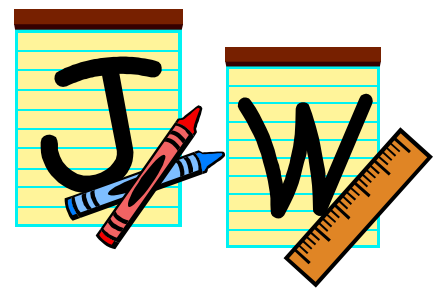

A big **THANK YOU** to Victoria Mead and her committee for, once again, putting together a wonderful display of the many cultures that make up our community.

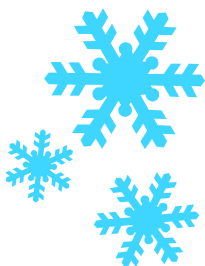
## Foster Farms Fosters Education
