Therefore, in order to give yourself the greatest chance of securing your match, <u>please do not submit your request</u> for match until October 1st, the start of Intel's 4th quarter. Any requests before that have a greater risk that they will NOT be matched. Your assistance with this is greatly appreciated. You can however still register your JW student(s) before Oct. 1 to PledgeStar where you can email friends and family to support their efforts.
