# April 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> now regular school days, NOT conference days

Our principal Ms. McFadden would like to get the word out that due to the change in school schedule this week and the cancellation of parent-teacher conferences, April 2<sup>nd</sup> & April 3<sup>rd</sup> are now regular school days with students attending school (NOT off days for conferences, as previously scheduled).

# What no volunteers means for JW in April

When school resumes April 1<sup>st</sup>, the parent volunteer exclusion and the canceling of nonessential events will still apply until further notice. We wanted to clarify this as it applies to JW programs and events:

- Film plastic drive suspended until further notice
- All parent volunteering (in-class and clerical) cancelled until further notice
- Passport Club suspended until further notice
- Art Literacy cancelled until further notice
- Junior Achievement suspended until further notice
- Walking School Bus cancelled until further notice
- March 31<sup>st</sup> 5<sup>th</sup> grade parent planning meeting cancelled
- April 7<sup>th</sup> PTO meeting cancelled
- Science Fun Competition (early May) may be subject to changes—see below for registration changes

### **Science Fun Competition changes**

As all are aware, the rapid escalation in the Covid-19 outbreak and the consequent rapid developments have led to school closures till (at least) 1<sup>st</sup> April 2020 and the announcement to curtail non-essential events and activities in our schools for about 1 month into April 2020. In this context, the Jacob Wismer PTO Science Fun Committee has consulted with the JW PTO about the fate of this year's Science Fun competition. Per inputs from the PTO, since the scheduled date of the competition (7<sup>th</sup> May 2020) is beyond the 1 month wait-and-watch period, it has been decided to continue with the plans for the competition for now. However, in view of the early school closure, the <u>committee has decided to extend the pre-registration window to Friday, 3<sup>rd</sup> April 2020 and the registration fee drop-off date to Wednesday, 8<sup>th</sup> April 2020.</u>

During this extended pre-registration period, we will continue to monitor any further developments and possible progress in the Covid-19 situation and take further actions/decisions – including cancellation of the competition, if necessary – based on the situation at that time, considering any concerns of our JW community.

We wish all of you are well and safe as we go through all of this.
