Oregon Battle of the Books (OBOB) - Overall Chair and Grade-Level Chairs needed:
OBOB is a competition where 3rd-5th grade students read books and compete in teams to answer questions based on those books. The Chair registers the school for the competition and works with Grade-Level Chairs to schedule battles and volunteer judges. Grade-Level Chairs ensure there are parent volunteers for each battle.
